SAGINAW CHIPPEWA INDIAN TRIBE DISTRIBUTION CENTER
MT. PLEASANT, MI

Mt. Pleasant, Michigan — a.j. Veneklasen, Inc. (AJV) has completed the new Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe Distribution Center in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan.

This Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe warehouse and distribution center occupies more than 59,000 square feet separated into five specialized and unique spaces. All food, equipment, and materials used by the tribe's facilities will pass through this distribution center. Internally, the building is secured with electronic security provisions allowing only authorized personnel into specific areas.

One of the focal points of this project is the custom built cold storage/freezer that encompasses approximately 6,000 square feet with a ceiling height of 18'. The building shell is constructed of 11' wide pre-cast concrete panels that utilized custom molds to create the design reflected in the picture. What appears to be 3 different sections of the wall is, in fact, a single concrete panel.
